



U.S. EXPORT LICENSE POLICY

Certain Pumpac model pumps require an export or re-export license issued by the U.S. Department of Commerce, Bureau of Industry and Security (BIS) to be exported to many countries. These pumps have parts made of one or more of the following materials: Kynar, PTFE or Viton. Model requiring export licenses are listed in Attachment A.

If any Pumpac distributor to whom any pump listed on Attachment A is to be shipped is located in a country listed in Attachment B, Pumpac must obtain an export or re-export license prior to shipment. The license may be obtained by following the procedures contained on Pumpac's Export License Application (a copy of which is attached). No Pumpac employee or representative is permitted to export any pump listed on Attachment A to any customer or distributor in a country listed in Attachment B without first securing the required license from the BIS. Failure to secure any required licenses shall be grounds for immediate termination.

If any domestic Pumpac distributor is selling or shipping any of the referenced pumps to a customer, consignee or end-user located in a country listed in Attachment B, that distributor must obtain an export or re-export license from BIS for any transaction involving any of the referenced diaphragm pumps. This license must be obtained prior to the pumps being shipped to any such country.

If any domestic Pumpac distributor is selling any of the referenced pumps to a customer, consignee or end-user located in a country listed in Attachment B, and if Pumpac will be directly shipping the pumps to that customer, consignee or end-user, the domestic distributor must inform Pumpac of this fact and Pumpac must obtain the required export license prior to the shipment.

Information on obtaining export or re-export licenses from BIS can be found at <http://www.bis.doc.gov/licensing/index.htm>. The Export Control Classification Number (ECCN) for the pumps referenced on Attachment A is ECCN 2B350.

Failure to obtain the required export or re-export licenses can result in:

- penalties from the U.S. government, including monetary fines, imprisonment and/or restrictions on your ability to trade in U.S. origin products;
- limitations by Pumpac on the distributor's access to certain Pumpac products, up to and including being barred from distributing any Pumpac products.

Compliance with U.S. export controls is of paramount importance to Pumpac.
